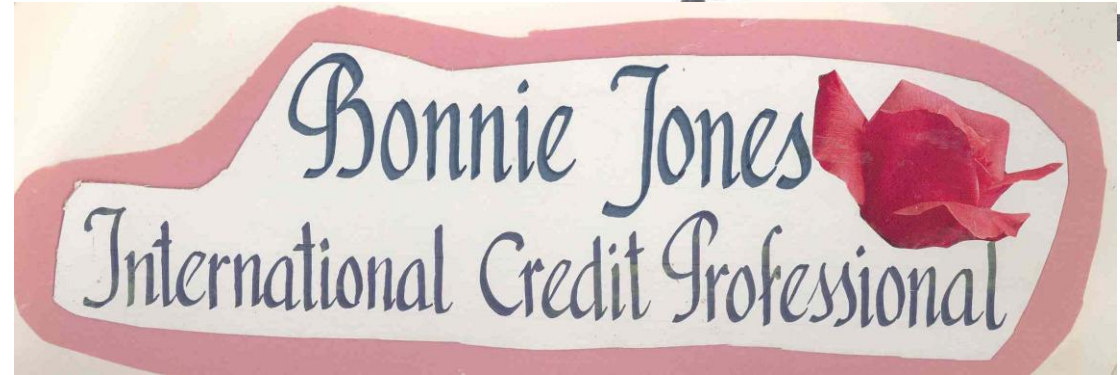
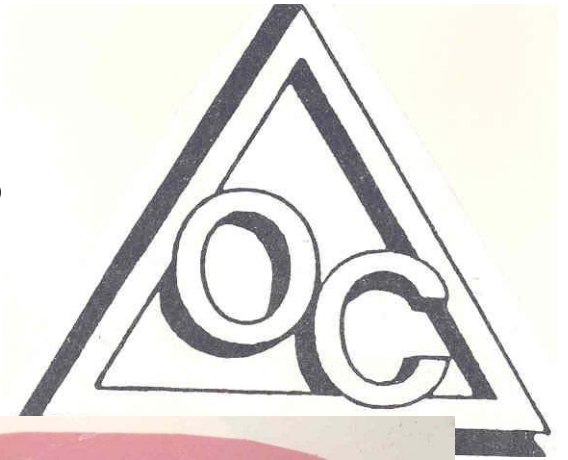

Bonnie was presented this award at their recent convention in San Diego, Calif. She competed against 13 other nominees from the United States and Canada.

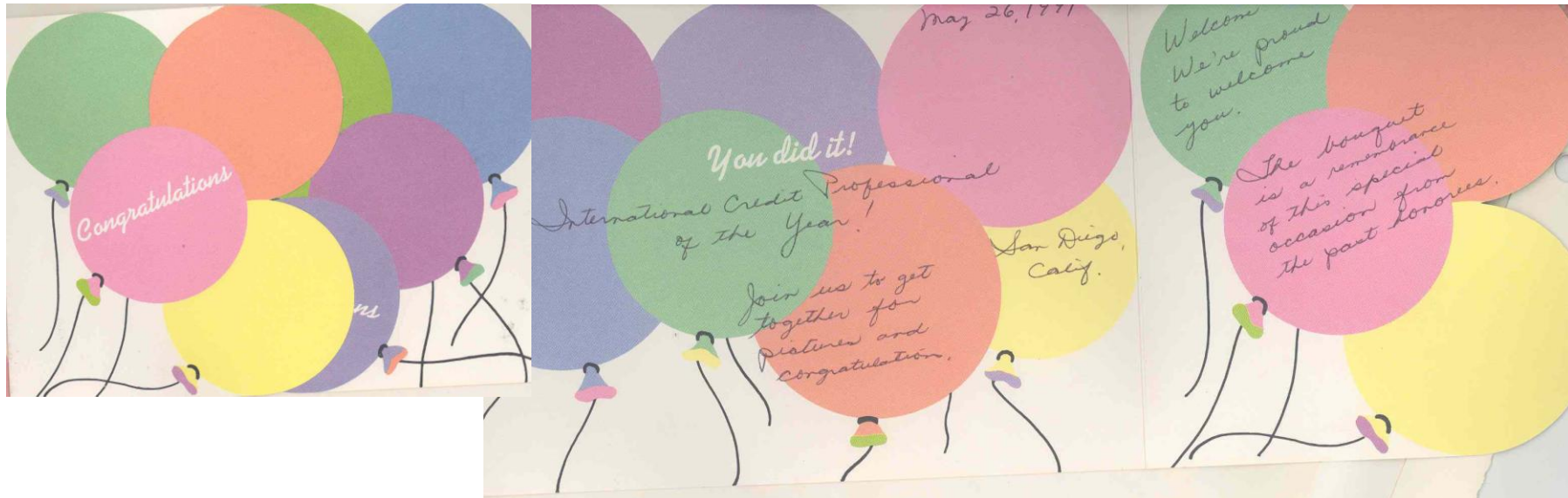
Credit Professionals International is a non-profit educational association of persons employed in the fields of credit or collections.

First I want to congratulate you again on your achievement of Credit Professional of the Year. It is well deserved and we are proud to have you represent our association in this role.

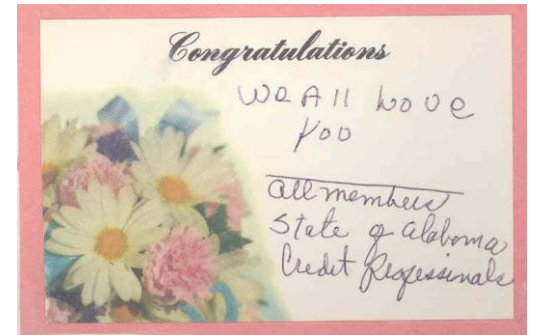

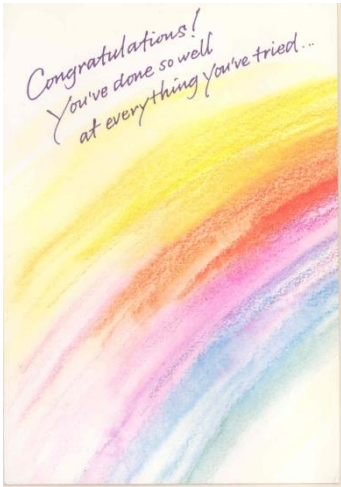
