Nebeker has held the office of president in the local Rocket Club of CPI twice, most recently in 1995-96. She has also served as District Nine president and CPI International president.

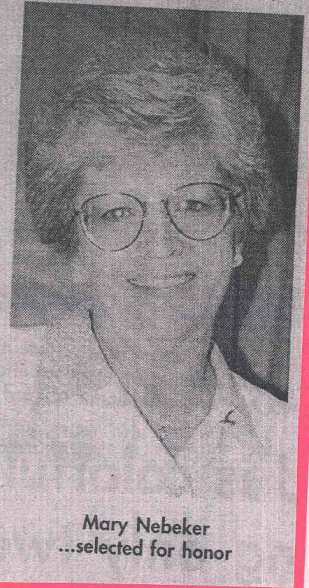

Academy Mortgage in Brigham City. A Brigham City resident, she is the mother of two and has four grandchildren.

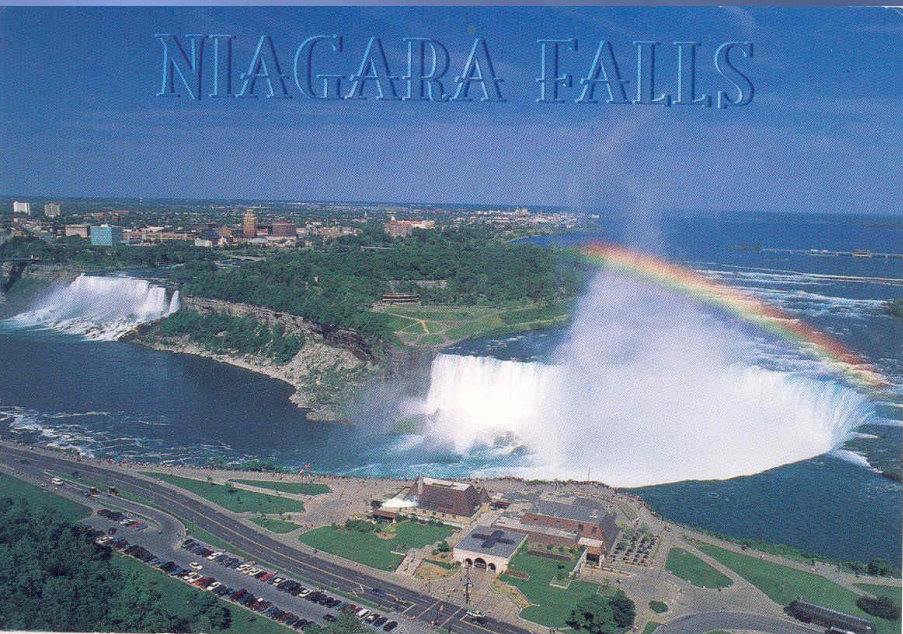
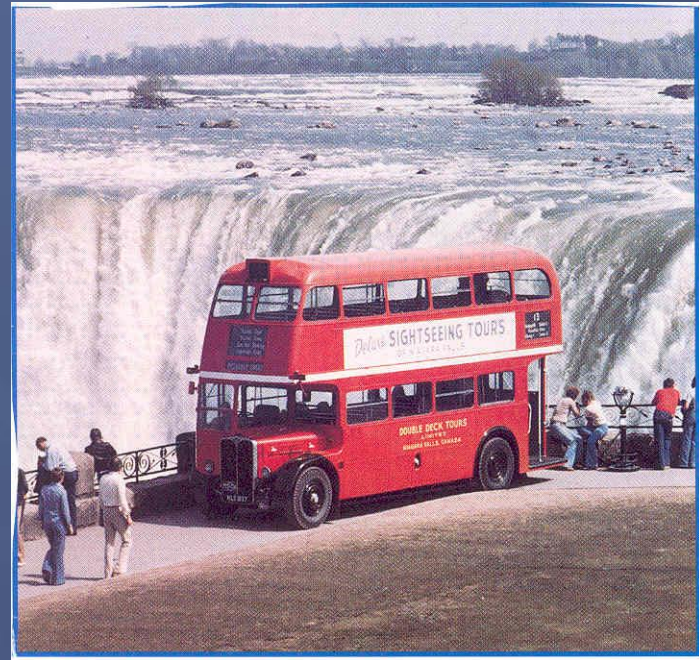
